Our 2023 membership was 46 with 9 new members for the year. Our current paid membership stands at 36. We truly appreciate that so many find value in our meetings and in support of the Club repeaters. Our VE Team continues to provide opportunities to become an amateur or to upgrade. Thanks to the VE Team: K9LBB, KV9W, WA9JWL, K9DYR, W9EEL, K9ALC, K9TZJ, N9IKE, N9VZL, WA9CWE, NA9LA, AK9JS, KB9Y. This year our team again offers testing on the third Tuesday of each month. If you would like to upgrade, or if you know of someone who wants to become licensed you can "walk-in". Our testing opportunities are posted in the ARRL Web Site listing.

REMINDER: The Amateur Extra Class test question pool changes on July 1, 2024. If you are considering upgrading you might consider this update. When a question pool is updated it looks like this: 82 new questions, 101 question eliminated, 350 modified to improve wording. In this case the Extra question pool will have 603 questions of which 50 will be on the test.

You may know that on November 13, the FCC rule changed to remove symbol rate restrictions on amateur radio digital emissions. <u>http://www.arrl.org/news/arrl-hails-fcc-action-to-remove-symbol-rate-restrictions</u>. This has resulted in 2 questions being changed in the General Class question pool (G1C05 and G1C02). If you are studying for General you might look for the update in the on-line testing that hopefully you are utilizing from one of many sources.

We believe there are many of you who have experiences related to amateur radio that you can share with the members at a meeting. Please think about offering a technical session or at least tell us what you think would be of interest. It doesn't have to be a polished presentation, just offer us what excites you in the hobby.

Questions have been raised as to how to renew your amateur radio license. It can be done thru various organizations that will do it for you for a fee. However, you can do it yourself on-line. The October issue of QST had an article walking thru the steps. We have placed this article on our website for your reference as your renewal approaches. Look under "License Exams" for a link "License Renewal Information". We might all take time to update our information in the new FCC CORES system. The old system didn't automatically take our information and link it to our FRS number. We have to do that ourselves. This article explains the quick steps to accomplish that.

As a relatively new operator, I am excited and looking forward to the upcoming events and activities for this year. I invite and encourage you to join us for another year of friendship and fellowship.

KC9JWO – 223.860 Trustee Lynn Edens K9RLE

Did some testing recently... Jeff, Lynn, Ferrin... took a 220 radio back there... disconnected antenna... plugged it into a 220 radio... fairly certain antenna system is not the issue... Issue seems to be the repeater itself... Up to the club to decide next steps...

Took 220 antenna from ceiling... put it on 20 foot mast... different 220 radio in ECC... could talk to Indy and hit their repeater without any problems

Asked about running coax directly into the radio room... would need to go through 4 12" concrete walls... cannot run it outside and back in... cost prohibitive... to remain in compliance installed a temporary antenna... EMA no longer needs 220 system... up to the club to maintain/repair

DISCUSSION... can we send the repeater back and have it retuned...

Problem is somewhere in the repeater system, not the antenna. Internal to repeater...

Several people have looked at it and cannot identify the issue...

Doug N9DR will look at it...

Dale N9OLC and Doug N9 DR both have 220 SWR meters... Repeater is not tolerant of SWR issues... especially with duplexer.

Public safety tower... only one person can climb... $cost \sim 1000 to climb the tower. A variety of other options are being explored looking for a cost effective solution.
